A **Charrette** for community development is a series of compressed meetings and design sessions used to facilitate creative problem solving with a multidisciplinary team of professionals, stakeholders and interested parties. This 2-7 day community participatory process includes three feedback loops in order to create a feasible plan that is informed by legal, financial, environmental, social and economic disciplines. By accelerating decision making, and encouraging people to abandon their regular working patterns promotes “out of the box” thinking.

The **Scotlandville Design Charrette** will continue the work started at the Listening Tour, Vision Workshops, Planning Charrette, and Feedback Tour. The Planning Charrette held on April 13-17, 2010 identified the broad ideas the community wants addressed. The purpose for this charrette is to further develop the conceptual plan and begin the process of setting priorities, defining action steps and implementation measures, funding strategies, and monitoring of the final plan development. We want to hear from you and need your participation as we begin to develop **Your Plan** for the future of Scotlandville.
