Su-Ceed is an on-going U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funded project that has been implemented to restore a once vibrant North Baton Rouge area known as University Place. The project was initiated through a community needs assessment survey through a ‘door to door’ method developed by the Center for Social Research. The *Rebuild Baton Rouge* Project will educate community residents about the city/parish planning and funding process, assist in collecting valuable resident needs and visions, summarize and prioritize the residents’ desires and provide the completed information to the residents and city/parish government. Community organizing activities will include networking community based organizations with the target community to engage in advocacy. Community-based organizational meetings and other public meetings as necessary will be used to (1) determine collaborative community based programmatic needs and (2) provide training on community needs assessment strategies and organizing skill development.
